Swimming Pool Rules

Swimming or sunbathing is permitted only during operating hours. Pool Hours and Opening dates vary. No solo swimming or swimming before sunrise or after sunset is permitted unless lifeguards are on duty.

Attire

Homeowners and guests should dress in attire befitting the family nature of our Community. Extremely revealing attire, such as a thong bathing suit, is not suitable for the family atmosphere of the pool.

Authority

These rules and regulations are designed to ensure the enjoyment and safety of swimmers. Parents are ultimately responsible for their child's safety. The HOA and its designated representatives shall have the authority to remove anyone from the pool area that is not abiding by the rules.

The Board and Association reserve the right to deny access to the pools to anyone for any reason at any point in time.

Balls and Other Recreational Objects

- Balls: The throwing of tennis or other "hard" balls and Frisbees is prohibited. Squishy balls designed for pool usage are allowed.
- Rafts and flotation devices are prohibited. Noodles and flotation devices designed for young children unable to swim are permitted.

Children

- Parents/Guardians must insure that infants and children using the pools do not have a diarrheal illness
- Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied at all times by an adult (18 years of age or older). Children ages 14-17 years of age do not qualify as an adult, and may swim unaccompanied but may not supervise younger children.
- Non-potty trained children must wear plastic, water-tight pants in addition to swim diapers. All children must be taken to the restroom to "potty." Changing diapers in the pool area is a violation of the Health Code.
- Children requiring flotation devices to assist in swimming are not allowed in the deep end of the pool unless accompanied by an adult. Lifeguards may exclude anyone from the deep water who has not demonstrated sufficient ability to swim.
- The baby pool is not monitored by lifeguards. Children in the baby pool are the responsibility of the parent or guardian. Children over the age of 5 are not permitted in the baby pool.

Contamination

Any Homeowner found contaminating the pool is subject to a fine and/or suspension of amenity privileges.

- Each individual should shower and rinse thoroughly before using the pools
- No Food or Drink are allowed within 5 feet of the pool
- Bathers with open wounds, skin conditions or any communicable condition are not allowed
- There is to be no spitting, "spouting," or blowing of noses in the pool

Glass and Sharp Objects

There are to be no glass containers, sharp objects, or other hazardous materials in the pool area.

Gates

Pool gates must remain closed and locked at all times. Gates must not be propped open, and gates should not be opened for homeowners or guests that do not have a functioning remote access card.

Guest Policy

Each household in good standing may bring up to four (4) accompanied guests at any one time. Residents under the age of 21 may bring (2) accompanied guests at any one time. Unaccompanied guests are not permitted.

Gum

No gum is allowed in the pool area.

Lifeguards

- No one should engage any lifeguard in unnecessary conversation
- Climbing or diving from Lifeguard stands is prohibited

Loitering

Loitering will not be permitted on the pool grounds.

Pets and Service Animals

No pets are allowed in the recreational facilities. Service animals are allowed.

Profanity

Absolutely no abusive, offensive or profane language will be permitted.

Mechanical and Storage Areas

Employees and designated agents of the Association are the only persons allowed access to the guard room, storage closets, mechanical and pump rooms, and attic.

Radios

Radio volume shall be kept at a level that does not disturb others.

Reservations

Usage of all areas of the pool is on a "first come, first served" basis. No reservations are allowed, and no decorations, balloons or other paraphernalia are permitted in the pool area or pool buildings.

Running and Horseplay

Running and horseplay in the pool area is prohibited. Any activity that disturbs other guests is prohibited.

Smoking, Tobacco and Controlled Substances

- No smoking, use of e-cigarettes, vaping, or use of any tobacco product is permitted in the pool area.
- Controlled substances are prohibited

- Anyone appearing intoxicated from the influence of alcohol or narcotics or will be denied admission

Swim at Own Risk

Use of the Wyngate POA pools is allowed on a SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK basis. Wyngate is not responsible for accidents or injury as a result of pool usage by homeowners or their invited guests.

Swimming Lessons

All private and group swim lessons are to be given by HOA approved vendors only.

Trash

It is the homeowner's responsibility to dispose of or remove any trash from the pool area that they created.
